Team "Anyting Goes" and sponsor Hormell's Extreme ATV's did Cajun Country proud at the recent Mud Nationals in Jacksonville, Texas. Extreme ATV owner Ryan Hormell says he and the team have been going to this and similar events for the last 10 years, and Team Anyting Goes again did not disappoint as one of the top teams in the nation.

The event, which was held March 24 through March 28, included several 4-Wheeler (bike) competitions, including a EPI Endurance Challenge, Mudda-Cross, Mud Bog and Mud Chick shootouts.

Jimmy and the whole group are great, and they are fun to be around and have fun with on rides, not just racing."
